Students take a further 30 credits of their chosen second subject to complete a Joint Subject degree. Alternatively, students take a further 20 credits in their major language subject and 10 credits in their minor language subject continued from Second Year (this is only in the case of students taking the following language subject(s): French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish or English).

Students will be assessed by a language tutor and directed to the class most appropriate to their level of proficiency

Preferably, students may choose one or two of the following languages/subjects: French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish or English and one or two other subjects permitted by the timetable.

Asian Studies Joint and Major students may take a maximum of 20 credits of language per year in year 2 of the programme. Note: Students must take 10 credits of language. At UCC, students will be assessed by a language tutor and directed to the class most appropriate to their level of proficiency.
