The BA (Hons) (Arts-Music) (International) Pathway is a four-year, full-time programme leading to the BA (Hons) (Art-Music) (International).

First Year - Arts (Arts-Music)

In First Arts (Arts-Music) students study prescribed modules to the value of 60 credits, taking Music together with two other subjects from the First Arts-Music (https://ucc-ie-public.courseleaf.com/programmes/bamus/) programme.

Second Year - Arts (Arts-Music) (International Pathway)

No student may register for Second Arts (Arts-Music) (International) Pathway until s/he has passed the First University Examination in Arts (Arts-Music). The selection of any module is conditional on the Professor or Lecturer concerned and the College being satisfied that a student is capable of profiting by attendance thereat. Students may not select modules which involve a timetable clash.

In Second Arts-Music (International) Pathway, students take Music as a Single Subject (50 credits) or a Major Subject (40 credits) or a Joint Subject (30 credits).

Third Year - Arts (Arts-Music) (International Pathway)

Students who wish to spend their third year abroad register for the BA Hons Arts-Music (International) Pathway during Second Year.

Students complete the Third Year of BA Hons Arts-Music (International) Pathway at a host university abroad where students will study approved courses/modules to the equivalent value of 60 credits. All courses will be assessed by the approved Host University.

No student may register for Third Arts (Arts-Music) (International Pathway) until s/he has passed the Second University Examination in Arts (Arts-Music) (International) Pathway.

Fourth Year - Arts (Arts-Music) (International Pathway)

No student may register for Fourth Arts (Arts-Music) (International Pathway) until s/he has passed the Third University Examination in Arts (Arts-Music) (International) Pathway. The selection of any module is conditional on the Professor or Lecturer concerned and the College being satisfied that a student is capable of profiting by attendance thereat. Students may not select modules which involve a timetable clash.

In Fourth Arts-Music (International Pathway), students take Music as a Single Subject (50 credits) or a Major Subject (40 credits) or a Joint Subject (30 credits).

Students follow the same curriculum as students taking Third Arts-Music (https://ucc-ie-public.courseleaf.com/programmes/bamus/).
