- <sup>3</sup> Students who have taken LT1001 in Year 2 may take Latin as a 15-credit or 10-credit subject (see requirements for Year 2) in Year 4, subject to timetable constraints.
- <sup>4</sup> Students who have not taken Latin in Year 1 or Year 2 may take it as a new subject in Year 4, subject to timetable constraints.
