- $^{\rm 6}\,$  For students wishing to take up a placement in China, it is compulsory to have successfully completed CH1001 Chinese Language (Mandarin) I in either First or Second Year.
- FR2105 and FR2107 are available only to students who have already taken FR1105 and FR1107 in First Year.

- Students whose placement takes place in Semester 1 will only be able to choose modules from this list that are offered in Semester 2 and students whose placement takes place in Semester 2 will only be able to choose modules from this list that are offered in Semester 1.
