Elective Choices: of the 30 elective credits to be taken, 15 credits must be chosen from Semester 1 electives and 15 credits from Semester 2 electives.

Semester 1 elective choices include: AC4100, EC4224, IS4419, IS4434, IS4437, IS4439, IS4441, IS4445, IS4449, IS4451, and MG4401. Semester 2 elective choices include: AC4101, EC3216, IS4420, IS4438, IS4447, IS4442, IS4446, IS4450, IS4452, and MG4402.

Some modules in Semester 2, have pre-requisites (IS4420 and IS4446). This means that a student who wishes to register for these modules needs to also register from its pre-requisite module in Semester 1. For
