## Elective Modules

Elective modules must, therefore, be chosen in consultation with the appropriate Head of Department. In exceptional cases, the Academic Board of the School of Biological, Earth and Environmental Sciences and the College will be prepared to consider applications for alternative elective modules in Third Year. Modules that have been taken and passed in one year of study may not be re-taken in a subsequent year.

The Fourth Science Research Project **must** be passed for the award of a BSc (Hons) Degree.

## BSc Ordinary Degree - NFQ Level 7, Major Award

Students who pass Third Year may choose not to proceed to Fourth Year and may opt instead to be conferred with a BSc Ordinary Degree.
