MSC (HEALTH PROFESSIONS' EDUCATION)

Overview

The MSc (Health Professions' Education) is an online programme. The programme runs over three years. Years 1 and 2 each run over an academic year (nine months) and Year 3 runs over an calendar year (twelve months). There is no work placement element to the programme; however, students are expected to have access to teaching opportunities to allow completion of compulsory assignments.

Entry to the programme is via the Postgraduate Certificate in Health Professions' Education (https://ucc-ie-public.courseleaf.com/programmes/pchpe/). All students will be registered for the Postgraduate Certificate in Health Professions' Education in the first instance.

Note: Students must complete the MSc programme within 3 academic years from the date of successful completion of the Postgraduate Diploma Examinations. Successful completion of MH6023 is required to complete the MSc in Palliative Care.
