The MSc in Nursing is a full time programme tailored specifically for non-EU students. The total number of credits taken is 90 and the programme is delivered full time over 1 calendar year which commences in September of each year.

The course content is mainly delivered through face to face lectures/ tutorials and supervision sessions. Some modules are delivered in a hybrid format. This means that the course content is delivered in 2 ways either face to face or online in a blended format using a virtual learning environment, known as Canvas.

The programme is designed to enable Master's Students to practise and teach from a scientific and evidence base. The specific focus of the programme is to facilitate personal, professional and scholarly development in students and to enable graduates to lead with knowledge and integrity based on a caring philosophy in an increasingly complex health-care environment.
