The MSc (Paediatrics and Child Health) is a part-time programme that runs over 3 academic years (27 months). Students take modules to a total value of **90** credits.

All students will be registered for the Postgraduate Certificate in Paediatrics and Child Health (<https://ucc-ie-public.courseleaf.com/programmes/pcpch/>) in the first instance and will be conferred with the Postgraduate Certificate upon passing modules to the value of 30 credits. All successful students will be offered a place on the Postgraduate Diploma in Paediatrics and Child Health.

On successful completion Postgraduate Diploma in Paediatrics and Child Health (<https://ucc-ie-public.courseleaf.com/programmes/pdpch/>), students will have the opportunity to progress to the MSc (Paediatrics and Child Health).

In the last academic year students undertake a research dissertation (30 credits) which is submitted at the end of the academic year.
