# MSC (SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT - LEAN SCM BLACK BELT)

#### **Overview**

#### NFQ Level 9, Major Award

Entry to the MSc (Supply Chain Management - Lean SCM Black Belt) programme is only via the Postgraduate Diploma in Supply Chain Management - Lean SCM Black Belt (https://ucc-ie-public.courseleaf.com/programmes/pdscm/).

The MSc in Supply Chain Management - Lean SCM Black Belt is a parttime programme running for 6 months from the date of first registration for the programme.

Students complete and submit a 12,000 - 15,000 word dissertation which will be supported by a seminar series. Depending on the area of research a student will register for a **30** credit module under the supervision of an academic in one of the following departments: Management and Marketing; Food Business and Development; Accounting, Finance and Information Systems.
