Students complete research leading to the completion and submission of the thesis (normally around 80,000 words or equivalent).

- Team taught, blended delivery seminar focusing on the history and theory of the practice of digital and technologised art and the political and ideological issues of digital culture.
- Team-taught virtual seminar focusing on innovation in Digital Humanities, driven by theoretical reflection and technical skilling.
- Modules selected in Year 1 cannot be selected in Year 2 or Year 3.
- Student placement with national and international academic partners, cultural institutions, and industrial and commercial businesses.
